

French Bulldog Fruit List

It is safe to feed some fruits to your French Bulldog. However, many fruits are high in sugar, so we personally only allow it a couple of times a week and in very small quantities.

If feeding any fruit to your Frenchie, wash it thoroughly, remove any skin, rind, peel or seeds. Some seeds in fruit will contain trace levels of cyanide. When eaten in large volume this can lead to kidney and health issues.

Apricots	Yes (but not recommended)	Remove seeds.
Avocados	No	Contains large stones and persin.
Bananas	Yes	Remove peel.

Cantaloupe	Yes	Remove seeds and rind.
Cherries	Yes (but not recommended)	Remove pits and stones.
Coconuts	Yes (but not recommended)	Remove the husk.
Cranberries	Yes	Make sure no raisins mixed in.
Dates	Yes (but not recommended)	Remove pits and stones.
Figs	Yes (but not recommended)

Gooseberries	No	
Grapes	No	Highly toxic to dogs.
Honeydew Melon	Yes	Remove seeds and rind.
Jackfruit	Yes (but not recommended)	
Kiwis	Yes (but not recommended)	Remove the seeds and skin.

Lychees	Yes (but not recommended)	Unripened can be toxic.
Mangoes	Yes	Remove the seeds and skin.
Melon	Yes	Remove seeds and rind.
Nectarines	Yes (but not recommended)	Remove pits and stones.
Olives	Yes (but not recommended)	Remove pits and stones.
Oranges	Yes	Remove peel, pith and seeds.
Papayas	Yes (but not recommended)	Remove seeds.
Passion Fruit	No	

Peaches	Yes (but not recommended)	Remove pits and stones.
Pears	Yes	Remove seeds.
Pineapples	Yes (but not recommended)	Remove the husk, skin, and seeds.
Plums	Yes (but not recommended)	Remove the seeds and pits.
Pomegranate	Yes (but not recommended)	As long as no tannin present.
Raisins	No	Highly toxic to dogs.
Raspberries	Yes	
Strawberries	Yes	
Tangerines	Yes	Remove seeds.
Tomatoes	No	Contains solanine.
Watermelons	Yes	Remove seeds and rind.
Zucchini (Courgettes)	Yes
